5536 STUDENT RANDOM DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING

The Manasquan High School Board of Education believes firmly that it is the responsibility of the district to help safeguard the health, character, citizenship, and personal development of the pupils in its schools. Therefore, we must maintain that the unlawful possession and use of illegal drugs, steroids, and alcohol is wrong and harmful. The Board recognizes that the misuse of drugs, steroids, and alcohol threatens the positive development of pupils and the welfare of the entire school community. The Board of Education is committed to the prevention of drug, steroid, and alcohol abuse and to the rehabilitation of identified abusers.

The Board of Education further recognizes that the problem of illegal drug, steroid, and alcohol use presents a continuing challenge and a clear danger to the school population as a whole. The district's commitment to maintaining the integrity of athletics and excellent co-curricular programs requires a clear policy and supportive programs relating to the detection and prevention of substance abuse by pupils involved in athletics and co-curricular activities.

Participation in athletics and co-curricular activities is a privilege. Pupil participants, by virtue of their voluntary decision to participate in these co-curricular and athletic activities and because of their position as school leaders and role models in the school community, have a heightened responsibility to be drug, steroid, and alcohol free. The district is committed to being proactive in ensuring the safety of all pupils participating in athletics and co-curricular activities. Therefore, the Board of Education reserves the right to implement a random testing program in addition to examining pupils where there is reason to suspect drug, steroid, and alcohol abuse.

Consistent with the U.S. Supreme Court ruling, Board of Education of Independent School District No. 92 of Pottawatomie County et al v. Earls et al., 536 U.S. 822 (2002) and the New Jersey Supreme Court ruling in Joye v. Hunterdon Central Regional High School Board of Education, 176 N.J. 568 (2003), it is the policy of the Board of Education to direct the Chief School Administrator to implement and conduct a program of random drug testing of pupil participants in athletics, co-curricular activities, school clubs, and pupils who have elected to participate in the program with necessary parental consent. Eligibility The testing year shall be in effect from the beginning of the fall practice season through the end of the school calendar year. The Principal or her/his designee shall oversee the policy and procedure.

This policy and its implementation regulations will supplement our existing comprehensive program of drug, steroid, and alcohol education, prevention, and intervention. This program will expand our existing programs aimed at the identification

and remediation of pupils involved with drugs, steroids, and alcohol. This program will be therapeutic and disciplinary in nature allowing for the opportunity to refer identified users of drugs, steroids, and alcohol to an appropriate substance abuse program as recommended by the Department of Health.

This policy will comply with the confidentiality requirements established in Federal regulations found at 42 CFR Part II. The policy and procedures set forth will comply with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 18A:40A-12 addressing the reporting of pupils suspected of being under the influence of substances in school.

This policy and its implementation regulations will apply to all pupils who participate in any Manasquan High School athletics, co-curricular activities or school clubs, and pupils who elect to participate in the Random Drug Testing program with parental consent.

Overview

The procedure for random drug testing of pupils in athletics and extracurricular activities is accomplished in conjunction with an independent drug testing Vendor selected by the Board of Education. The Vendor is provided by the Designated Official a list of eligible pupils and in turn randomly selects these pupils for drug testing at irregular intervals. The Vendor will send qualified collectors to the school who will oversee the collection of all specimens as outlined in this document. The Vendor will provide Medical Review Officer (MRO) services for interpretation and verification of results. Results are reported to the Building Principal or Designated Official by the MRO. Specimens are collected as split specimens.

Eligibility for Testing

All pupils who participate in Manasquan High School athletics, co-curricular activities including school clubs, and pupils who elect to participate in the Random Drug Testing, including students who attend classes at any of the area vocational schools or academies, must complete a "Manasquan Code of Conduct and Expectations Informed Consent Agreement." Upon doing so, they will be entered into the random testing pool and be eligible for participation.

Pupils involved in co-curricular activities or school clubs must submit the informed consent agreement form to the Coach, Club Advisor, or Director of Athletics no later than their attendance at a second meeting. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility for participation in the activity or club.



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Pupil volunteers for the RDT Program shall be allowed to enter the RDT Pool at any time once they submit a completed informed consent agreement form.

Pupils remain eligible for Random Drug Testing from the date the administration receives a Manasquan Code of Conduct and Expectations Informed Consent Agreement form through their career at Manasquan High School when random student drug testing is in effect, whether or not they have been previously tested or are currently participating in athletics or co-curricular activities at the time they might be randomly selected for a drug test. In the event that a pupil eligible for random alcohol and drug testing ceases to participate or withdraws from all athletics, co-curricular activities or school clubs, he or she has the opportunity to submit to the Principal or administrative designee an Activity Drop Form. This Activity Drop Form shall remain in effect for a minimum of one calendar year, with a built-in fifteen day grace period for reconsideration. In order for a pupil's withdrawal to be effective and thereby remove him or her from the RDT Testing Pool, both the pupil and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must sign the pupil's Activity Drop Form.

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R 5536 STUDENT RANDOM DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING

Vendor Requirements

At a minimum, the vendor must be able to provide the following services:

1. Random Selection of Eligible Pupils

Once provided a list of eligible pupils, the vendor must select the required number of pupils in a random and confidential manner. The vendor will arrange with the designated official the days and times to do the collection of specimens. The schedule will not follow any recognizable pattern. The selected pupil names will be given to the designated official, who will arrange for these pupils to report to the collection area.

2. Collection of Urine Specimens

The vendor will oversee the collection of urine specimens. Chain of custody forms will be provided by the vendor that meets the criteria of this policy and that of the testing laboratory. Pupils will be given as much privacy as possible in the obtaining of the specimen.

3. Testing of Urine Specimens

The vendor will have all specimens tested for the specified illicit or banned substances by a qualified laboratory certified by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) following the guidelines of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). The testing laboratory should have greater than ten years experience in toxicology testing and chain-of-custody procedures. All specimens must be initially tested using a highly accurate immuno-assay technique, with "all presumptive positive results then confirmed by Gas Chromatography/Mass Spectrometry (GC/MS) or Liquid Chromatography with Tandem Mass Spectrometry (LC/MS/MS) confirmatory test." (New technology used in confirmation)

The testing laboratory must, at a minimum, be able to test for the following drug classes, substances or their metabolites in collected urine specimens.



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The Building Principal may specify specific classes or substances to be tested, or add illicit substances to this list as needed.

Alcohol

Amphetamines

Anabolic Steroids

Barbiturates

Benzodiazepines Cocaine Metabolites Marijuana Metabolites

Methadone

LSD MDMA (Ecstasy)

Opiates

Phencyclidine

Propoxyphene

4. Medical Review Officer (MRO) Services

The vendor will provide MRO services by a licensed physician who is certified by the Medical Review Officer Certification Council (MROCC) or the American Association of Medical Review Officers as having proven by examination to have had the appropriate medical training to interpret and evaluate drug test results and thus qualified for certification as a Medical Review Officer. Additionally the MRO must demonstrate a willingness to abide by the regulations for the Manasquan High School Random Drug Testing Policy as to the evaluation of positive drug tests and reporting findings in a timely and confidential manner. All results will be kept on file for a period of one year.

5. Reporting of Random Urine Test Results by Vendor

> The MRO will certify all urine drug screens as negative or positive. Positive findings will be reported by telephone in a confidential manner to the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) and then the Building Principal.

6. Statistical Reporting and Confidentiality of Urine **Drug Test Results**

> The vendor will provide the Building Principal with an annual report showing the number of tests performed, rate of positive and negative tests, and what substances were found in the positive urine specimens.

Procedures for Random Urine Drug Testing of Manasquan School District Pupils

1. List of Eligible Pupils



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The designated official will prepare a list of eligible pupils. This list will be forwarded to the vendor for the random selection of pupils who will submit urine specimens for testing.

2. Random Selection of Pupils for Testing

The vendor will use a system to assure that pupils are selected in a random fashion. This system will utilize a computer based system designed specifically for the purpose of randomly selecting individuals for drug testing.

3. Scheduling of Urine Drug Testing

Urine drug testing is unannounced. The day and date are selected by the designated official and confirmed with the vendor. Random testing may be done up to bi-weekly, but not during holidays and spring break.

4. Testing Year

The testing year begins August 15 for all fall sports and the first day of school for extra-curricular activities and continues to the end of the school year.

5. Form Completion

The vendor is responsible for seeing that proper drug testing custody and control forms are used that satisfy the needs of the policy for random urine drug testing of Manasquan School District pupils and the testing laboratory. A pupil number will be used for identification with the pupil's name only appearing on the copies that go to the donor, MRO, and school official.

6. Collection Process

Selected pupils are escorted from class to the collection site and their confidentiality will be maintained. A specimen of urine is collected following this process:

a. No purses, bags or containers may be taken into the collection area with the pupil. All extra coats, vests, jackets, sweaters, etc., are to be removed before entering the collection area.



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- b. The collector adds a bluing agent (food coloring) to the water in the urinal or toilet.
- c. Pupil is asked to rinse their hands and dry them. If no water is easily accessible, a non-alcoholic wipe may be used instead.
- d. The drug testing custody and control form is completed by the pupil and collector.
- e. The pupil is told to urinate directly into the provided container and should provide a sufficient amount of urine (at least 45mL) in one attempt. The pupil is also told they are to hand the container of urine to the collector.
- f. The pupil enters a closed stall to collect the specimen, and then hands the container to the collector.
- g. The collector checks the volume, reads and records the temperature within four minutes of collection, and looks for evidence of tampering. If tampering is suspected, a second specimen will be requested. A second suspected tampered specimen will be considered refusal to test and the designated official notified.
- h. With the pupil watching, the collector will pour the specimen into the two bottles and recap the specimen bottles tightly.
- i. The collector places the tamper evident seals over the vials and then presents them to the pupil to sign and initial.
- j. The sealed bottles are placed inside the transport bag.
- k. The top lab copies of the drug testing custody and control form are folded with the top portion visible to the outside and placed in the Requisition Pouch. The transport bag and pouch are sealed as indicated. The pupil completes the custody and control form and then retains the donor copy.
- l. The pupil may wash their hands and is then sent back to class.



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- m. The collector distributes the remaining copies of the form as required, being responsible for getting the appropriate copy of the form to the MRO in a timely manner.
- n. The designated official will be notified immediately of any pupil who refuses to give a urine sample or is suspected of adulteration. This will then be determined treated as a positive result.
- o. A phone call will be made to the parent/guardian that the student has been tested.
- 7. Medical Review Officer (MRO) Responsibilities

The MRO will review all results of urine drug testing. Any urine specimen testing positive for illicit drugs, banned substances, or adulteration will be handled in the following manner:

- a. The MRO determines if any discrepancies have occurred in the chain of custody.
- b. Depending on the substances found in the urine, if necessary the parent(s) or legal guardian(s)/custodian will be contacted to determine if the pupil is on any prescribed medication from a physician.
- c. The MRO will then determine if any of the prescribed medications resulted in the positive drug screen.
 - (1) For example, a drug screen positive for codeine may be ruled negative by the MRO when he receives a letter from the treating physician that the pupil has been prescribed Tylenol© with codeine as a pain medication following tooth extraction.
 - (2) Or, if the pupil has a positive drug screen for codeine and has no documented physician order for the medication (maybe a parent(s) or legal guardian(s) gave the pupil one of their pills), this would likely be ruled a positive drug test by the MRO.



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- (3) Drug screens positive for illicit drugs (marijuana, heroin, cocaine or alcohol, etc.) would automatically be considered positive by the MRO.
- d. The MRO may use quantitative results to determine if positive results on repeat tests indicate recent use of illicit or banned substances or the natural decline of levels of the illicit or banned substance from the body. In the professional opinion of the MRO if the quantitative levels are determined to be above the established cutoffs and do not reflect current use but natural decay, then a negative result may be reported.
- e. Finally, the MRO, based on the information given, will certify the drug test results as positive or negative. Positives will be reported to the Building Principal or designee by phone.

8. Pick-Up Process

The vendor is responsible for seeing that specimens are delivered to or picked up by the testing laboratory and the chain of custody form properly annotated.

9. Procedures in the Event of a Positive Result

Whenever a pupil's test result indicates the presence of illegal drugs or banned substances or adulteration, the following will occur after notification of the parent(s) or legal guardian(s):

- a. The Building Principal, within twenty-four hours, will notify the parent(s) or legal guardian(s)/custodian first, then the pupil and designated official of any positive results. The Building Principal may keep all test results for a period up to one year.
- b. The designated official will contact the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) to remove the pupil from school and make arrangements for the mandatory medical examination pursuant to the statute.
- c. The pupil will be notified and be required to submit up to four periodical urine tests throughout the next calendar year.



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- d. If the parent(s) or legal guardian(s)/custodian or pupils wish to contest the results, the vendor will arrange for the split portion of the specimen to be submitted to another laboratory approved by the Board of Education for testing. This is done at parent(s) or legal guardian(s)/custodian or pupil expense. Such a request must be made to the Building Principal in writing within five working days from first notification of positive test results.
- e. The MRO may use quantitative results to determine if positive results, on repeat testing indicate recent use of illicit or banned substances or the natural decline of levels of the illicit or banned substance from the body. In the professional opinion of the MRO if the quantitative levels are determined to be above the established cutoffs and do not reflect current use but natural decay, then a negative result may be reported.
- f. The consequences accrued under the RSDT Program are cumulative and will "carry over" throughout the pupil's four years at Manasquan High School.

10. First Positive Result

A first positive result by MRO ruling or adulteration will result in the participant being barred from participation in any athletic activity and co-curricular activity for a period of fifteen school days.

A positive result from the MRO or an altered sample will constitute a first positive. The designated official will contact the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) to remove the pupil from school and make arrangements for the mandatory medical examination pursuant to the statute.

Minimum of three counseling sessions with the Student Assistance Coordinator (SAC).

The Student Assistance Coordinator may conduct an evaluation with the pupil, parent(s) or legal guardian(s) and others deemed necessary to determine the appropriate level of treatment.



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The pupil must attend a prevention/education program or sign into and complete a drug/alcohol in-patient rehabilitation program. Attendance in the prevention/ education program or rehabilitation program must begin within one week of the offense. An information release form must be available to the Student Assistance Coordinator. The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) is responsible for the cost of the treatment program.

The pupil will provide a minimum of four subsequent drug tests after his/her initial positive test. Any test results indicating a relapse during this consecutive testing period will be considered a second infraction.

The pupil and / or their parent, guardian or legal representative will be responsible for reimbursing the district for subsequent follow up tests. The Student Assistance Coordinator will arrange for collection of payments.

Failure to comply with the guidelines stated above may result in intervention on behalf of the pupil's safety and well-being. This may include intervention meetings with the pupil, parent(s) or legal guardian(s), SAC and administration as well as referral to the Division of Youth and Family Services for investigation.

11. Second Positive Result

A second positive result by MRO ruling or adulteration will result in the participant being barred from participation in any athletic activity and extra-curricular activity for a minimum period of sixty consecutive school days.

The designated official will contact the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) to remove the pupil from school and make arrangements for the mandatory medical examination pursuant to the statute.

A minimum of six counseling sessions with the Student Assistance Coordinator (SAC).

The Student Assistance Coordinator may conduct an evaluation with the pupil, parent(s) or legal guardian(s) and others deemed necessary to determine the appropriate level of treatment.

The pupil must attend a prevention/education program or sign into and complete a drug/alcohol in-patient rehabilitation program. Attendance in the prevention/ education program or rehabilitation program must begin within one week of the offense. An information release form must be available to the Student Assistance Coordinator. The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) is responsible for the cost of the treatment program.

The pupil will provide a minimum of four subsequent drug tests after his/her initial positive test. Any test results indicating a relapse during this consecutive testing period will be considered a third infraction.

Failure to comply with the guidelines stated above may result in intervention on behalf of the pupil's safety and well being. This may include intervention meetings with the pupil, parent(s) or legal guardian(s), SAC and administration as well as referral to the Division of Youth and Family Services for investigation.

12. Third Positive Result

A third positive result by MRO ruling or adulteration will result in the participant being barred from participation in any athletic activity and extra-curricular activity for a minimum period of one calendar year.

The designated official will contact the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) to remove the pupil from school and make arrangements for the mandatory medical examination pursuant to the statute.

The pupil must attend complete a drug/alcohol in-patient rehabilitation program or an Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP). Attendance in the rehabilitation program must begin within one week of the offense. An information release form must be available to the Student Assistance Coordinator. The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) is responsible for the cost of the treatment program.

The pupil will provide a minimum of four subsequent drug tests after his/her initial positive test.

Failure to comply with the guidelines stated above may result in intervention on behalf of the pupil's safety and well-being. This may include intervention meetings with the pupil, parent(s) or legal

guardian(s), SAC and administration as well as referral to the Division of Youth and Family Services for investigation.

13. Prescription Drug Error Policy

A pupil who is determined to have used a prescription drug without a legal prescription in their name will be given a positive test result by the MRO. If in meeting with the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) it is determined that this is the result of a parent(s) or legal guardian(s) error and not an intended abuse

of the substance, the following will occur: The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) will submit, in writing to the designated official, an explanation of the error and acknowledgement of the law in regards to prescription drugs. Upon receipt of this document and recognition as a reasonable explanation by the designated official, the suspension from activities will be lifted and no assessment or intervention will be required. The pupil will undergo a follow-up drug screen at the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) expense to ensure the banned substance(s) are gone or in decay. Upon completion of these requirements, this positive test will be removed from the pupil's record. This rule may only be applied one time in a pupil's enrollment within the school district. Further errors ruled positive by the MRO will constitute the actions listed above.

14. Non-Punitive Nature of Policy

No pupil will be penalized academically for testing positive for illegal drugs or banned substances. The results of drug tests pursuant to this policy will not be documented in any pupil's academic records. Information regarding the results of drug tests will not be disclosed to criminal or juvenile authorities absent legal compulsion by valid and binding subpoena or other legal process, which the Manasquan School District Board of Education will not solicit. In the event of service of any such subpoena or legal process, the pupil and the pupil's custodial parent, legal guardian, or custodian will be notified at least seventy-two hours before response is made by the Manasquan School Board of Education, to the extent permitted by such subpoena or legal process.

15. The district board of education shall establish a process for the annual review of the effectiveness of its policies and procedures on student alcohol and other drug abuse. The district board of education shall

solicit parent, student and community input, as well as consult in the review process with local alcohol and other drug abuse prevention, intervention and treatment agencies licensed by the Department of Human Services. The district shall annually disseminate to all school staff, students and parents its adopted policies and procedures for implementing N.J.A.C. 6A:16-4.

Definitions

Vendor - The medical office or company selected by the Board of Education to carry out the policy and procedure.

Designated Official - The individual hired by the school or district to oversee the drug testing program of the school or district.

Medical Review Officer (MRO) - A licensed physician trained and certified in the process and interpretation of drug testing results.

Illicit substance - A drug classified by the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) as being available only by prescription from a physician or classified as being controlled and having no therapeutic use.

Banned Substance - A substance defined by school policy as being banned from use by pupils.

Pupil Participant - A qualified pupil participating on a sanctioned athletic team as defined by the State Athletic Association or an extracurricular activity as defined by the Board.

SAMHSA - The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, a governmental agency that certifies toxicology laboratories that perform drug testing following strict guidelines and constant quality assurance programs.

GC/MS - Gas Chromatography/Mass Spectroscopy, a scientific process to identify specific chemical compounds. A molecular fingerprint is obtained that identifies a chemical compound with 100% accuracy.

Quantitative Levels - The measurement levels of specific chemicals in the urine reported usually in nanograms per milliliter (ng/m1).

Chain-of-Custody Form - A preprinted form provided by the testing laboratory that records all contact with the provided specimen. The form is initiated by the collector and donor then follows with the specimen until the results are certified by the testing scientist and forwarded to the MRO for final certification

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Adulterant/Adulteration - Any attempt to alter the outcome of a urine drug test by adding a substance to the sample, attempting to switch the sample, or otherwise interfere with the detection of illicit or banned substances in the urine, or purposefully over hydrating oneself in an attempt to dilute the urine to decrease possible detection of illicit or banned substances.

Co-curricular Activity - For the purpose of this policy, "co-curricular activity" shall be those activities which are sponsored or approved by the Board but are not offered for credit toward graduation.

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5300 <u>AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS (AEDS)</u>

The American Heart Association estimates many lives could be saved if defibrillators were more widely available. Due to technological advances, automated external defibrillators (AEDs) may be used by lay persons without any training to provide defibrillation within the first minutes of cardiac arrest thereby increasing the victim's chances of survival. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:40-41.a, the Board of Education shall ensure every school in the school district has an AED as defined in N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-24. The AED shall be made available in an unlocked location on school property with an appropriate identifying sign. The AED shall be accessible during the school day and any other time when a school-sponsored athletic event or team practice is taking place in which pupils of the school district are participating. The AED shall be within reasonable proximity of the school athletic field or gymnasium, as applicable.

A team coach, licensed athletic trainer, or other designated staff member if there is no coach or licensed athletic trainer, who is present during athletic events or team practices, shall be trained in cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and the use of the AED in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-25.a. The school district shall be deemed to be in compliance with N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-25.a, if a State-certified emergency services provider or other certified first responder is on site at the event or practice.

Each AED in the school district shall be tested and maintained according to the manufacturer's operational guidelines. Notification shall be provided to the appropriate first aid, ambulance, rescue squad, or other appropriate emergency medical services provider regarding the AED, the type acquired, and its location in accordance with N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-25.b and c.

The school district and its employees shall be immune from civil liability in the acquisition and use of AEDs pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-27.

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 18A:40-41.b, the Superintendent of Schools or designee shall establish and implement an Emergency Action Plan applicable to each school in the school district for responding to a sudden cardiac event including, but not limited to, an event in which the use of an AED may be necessary.

The Emergency Action Plan shall be consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 18A:40-41.a and, at a minimum, shall include a list of no less than five school employees, team coaches, or licensed athletic trainers who hold current certifications from the American Red Cross, American Heart Association, or other training programs recognized by the Department of Health and Senior Services in cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and in the use of an AED. This list shall be updated, if necessary, at least once in each semester of the school year. **This list will be kept in the nurse's office.** The Emergency Action Plan shall also include detailed procedures on responding to a sudden cardiac event including, but not limited to, the identification of the persons in the school who will be responsible for responding to the person experiencing the sudden cardiac event; calling 911; starting cardio-pulmonary resuscitation; retrieving and using the AED; and assisting emergency responders in getting to the individual experiencing the sudden cardiac event.

R 5300 Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs)

- 1. Every school in the school district shall have an AED as defined in N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-24.
- 2. For the purposes of this Policy and Regulation, "automated external defibrillator" or "defibrillator" or "AED" means a medical device heart monitor and defibrillator that:
 - a. Has received approval of its pre-market notification filed pursuant to 21U.S.C.§360(k) from the United States Food and Drug Administration;
 - b. Is capable of recognizing the presence or absence of ventricular fibrillation or rapid ventricular tachycardia, and is capable of determining, without intervention by an operator, whether defibrillation should be performed; and
 - c. Upon determining that defibrillation should be performed, automatically charges and requests delivery of an electrical impulse to an individual's heart.

B. Location and Availability of AED

- 1. The AED shall be made available in an unlocked location on school property with an appropriate identifying sign.
- 2. The AED shall be accessible during the school day and any other time when a school-sponsored athletic event or team practice is taking place in which pupils of the school district are participating.
- 3. The AED shall be within reasonable proximity of the school athletic field or gymnasium, as applicable.

- C. Training Requirements for Using an AED
 - 1. A team coach, licensed athletic trainer, or other designated staff member if there is no coach or licensed athletic trainer, who is present during athletic events or team practices, shall be trained in cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and the use of the AED in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-25.a.
 - a. The school district shall be deemed to be in compliance with this requirement if a State-certified emergency services provider or other certified first responder is on site at the event or practice.
 - 2. Prior to using an AED a school employee must have successfully completed and hold a current certification from the American Red Cross, American Heart Association, or other training programs recognized by the Department of Health and Senior Services in cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and the use of an AED.
 - a. The Board of Education shall not be liable for any act or omission of any lay person who uses the defibrillator in the rendering of emergency care.
 - 3. Each AED shall be maintained and tested according to the manufacturer's operational guidelines.
 - 4. The Principal or designee shall notify the appropriate first aid, ambulance, rescue squad, or other appropriate emergency medical services provider that the school has acquired an AED, the type acquired, and its location.
 - 5. Prior to purchasing an AED, the Superintendent of Schools or designee will provide the prescribing licensed physician with documentation that the school district has a protocol in place to comply with the requirements of 2., 3., and 4. above.

D. Immunity from Civil Liability

- 1. Any person who uses an AED shall request emergency medical assistance from the appropriate first aid, ambulance, or rescue squad as soon as practicable. However, a lay person who, in good faith, fails to request such emergency medical assistance shall be immune from civil liability for any personal injury that results from that failure.
- 2. The school district and its employees shall be immune from civil liability in the acquisition and use of AEDs pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-27.
 - a. Any person or entity who, in good faith, acquires or provides an AED, renders emergency care or treatment by the use of an AED, assists in or supervises the emergency care or treatment by the use of an AED, attempts to use an AED for the purpose of rendering emergency care or treatment, and who has complied with the requirements of Policy and Regulation 5300, N.J.S.A. 18A:40-41.a and b, and N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-23 through 2A:62A-27 shall be immune from civil liability for any personal injury as a result of that care or treatment, or as a result of any acts or omissions by the person or entity in providing, rendering, assisting in, or supervising the emergency care or treatment.
 - b. A person or entity providing or maintaining an AED shall not be liable for any act or omission involving the use of an AED in the rendering of emergency care by a lay person.
- 3. The immunity provided in 2. above shall include the prescribing licensed physician and the person or entity who provided training in cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and use of the AED.
- 4. N.J.S.A. 2A:62A-27 shall not immunize a person for any act of gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct. It shall not be considered gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct to

fail to use a defibrillator in the absence of an otherwise preexisting duty to do so.

- E. Emergency Action Plan
 - 1. The Superintendent of Schools or designee shall establish and implement an Emergency Action Plan applicable to each school in the district for responding to a sudden cardiac event including, but not limited to, an event in which the use of an AED may be necessary.
 - a. The Emergency Action Plan shall be consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 18A:40-41.a and, at a minimum, shall include a list of no less than five school employees, team coaches, or licensed athletic trainers in each school building who hold current certifications from the American Red Cross, American Heart Association, or other training programs recognized by the Department of Health and Senior Services in cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and in the use of the AED. This list shall be updated, if necessary, at least once in each semester of the school year.
 - b. The Emergency Action Plan shall also include detailed procedures on responding to a sudden cardiac event including, but not limited to:
 - (1) The identification of the persons in the school who will be responsible for responding to the person experiencing the sudden cardiac event;
 - (2) Calling 911;
 - (3) Starting cardio-pulmonary resuscitation;
 - (4) Retrieving and using the AED; and
 - (5) Assisting emergency responders in getting to the individual experiencing the sudden cardiac event.
